- All AM exams will start at 9.00am and all PM exams will start at 1.15pm unless otherwise stated (\*indicates 2 p.m start). Students must line up 15 minutes before exams start.
- Please pay particular attention to where each exam will take place
- Pens and pencils must be in a clear plastic bag as pencil cases, outdoor bags and coats are not allowed at exam desks. Calculator lids must not be brought into the exam room.
- Mobile phones should be switched off and placed in your bag. Wrist watches, MP3s and any electronic equipment must not be brought into the exams.
- Water may be brought into the exam room provided it is not fizzy and is in a screw-top plastic bottle (labels removed) – **no cans**.
- Students should line up in seat order number within relevant subject.
