Key Stage	Learning content
Years 7, 8	An introduction to the scientific world following the interesting and engaging ASE WIKID curriculum. Students are introduced to Biology, Chemistry, and Physics in themed lessons that unite the sciences.
Years 9, 10 & 11	Students embark on a three-year suite of GCSE's in Science. Students study separate units in Biology, Chemistry and Physics as well as completing a large number of required practicals, which build their experimental skills and introduce them to the way science works. Many students will eventually complete three GCSE's, one for each science while others will complete a combined science trilogy where all three are blended into two GCSE's.
