## Vision

Personal Development (PD) aims to give students the knowledge, skills and understanding they need to lead confident, healthy, independent lives and to become informed, active, employable, responsible citizens. PD promotes discussion of values and beliefs, extends knowledge and understanding, encourages practical activities and decision-making and furthers the inter-relationship of the individual and the community.
